

# Operational Definitions


- **Course substitutions:** On the individual student level a specific course can be substituted for another program requirement
- **Legacy course substitutions:** To ensure we live up to our promise of "Do No Harm" a streamlined substitution process will be enacted to allow for legacy courses taken prior to Fall 2023 to satisfy degree-requirements.
- **Course equivalencies:** A specific course is named as an equivalent to another course in BANNER. Either course will count in a degree audit and for pre-requisite checking.
- **Blanket course substitutions:** This is a common substitution that is needed for many students in a program. The degree audit software, DegreeWorks, can be programmed to allow for all instances of this course(s) substitution it is not for a particular student
- **Graduation credit variance:** To hold harmless all students who complete legacy degree or certificate requirements but, due to credit discrepancies solely created through the curriculum alignment process, are missing one or more credits to graduate from an equivalent CT State degree or certificate.

# Advising Updates

- Advisors are continually identifying issues with the merged curriculum.
- Collaboration with faculty and academic leadership is essential to ensure we "Do No Harm" to students.
- Advising appointments for continuing students:
  - Extremely time consuming (averaging 60 minutes)
  - Requires 12C and CT State DW, program crosswalks, and course substitutions
  - Most appointments require significant student follow-up
  - Collaboration with faculty and academic leadership is critical

# Degree Works

- Tool that reflects curriculum (catalog)
- Tickets received: 943
- Tickets resolved: 807
- Individual Course Substitutions Entered: 500
- Blanket Substitutions Entered: 38
  
- Refresher Degree Works trainings being scheduled
- Hit "process new" before reviewing a student's audit to ensure you are looking at the most up-to-date info

# Fall 2023 Registration Data

- Fall Registration Numbers
  - Seats: 27,886
  - Students: 10,238
- Web Registrations: 72%
- In Person Registrations: 28%
- Total students enrolled at multiple campuses: 2,198
